Janet Castrejon

Janet Castrejon (44 yrs.) a resident of **Las Cruces, New Mexico** was reported missing on **June 19, 2015** after she vanished in a remote section of the **Chiricahua National Monument** located near the Arizona-New Mexico border **east of Tucson**.

Castrejon is **partially blind, and has the mental capacity of a five-year-old person** due to injuries she had sustained as a result of an auto accident at the age of 18. Janet Castrejon does have verbal abilities, but she has permanent memory loss and may become easily confused.

Janet is described as a Caucasian female, 44 years of age, 5' 3" tall, 250 lbs., with dark brown eyes, and long black hair worn in a braid. Janet has two visible scars: one on the front of her neck (tracheotomy) and another scar is located on her head, under her hairline. Janet was last seen wearing a **white T-shirt with black lettering, blue jeans, and white tennis shoes with a red stripe**.

Those close to the investigation are extremely concerned that she **may have been taken against her will**. The area in which Janet Castrejon was last seen is close to the border with Mexico. **Drug smugglers and human traffickers are commonly known to frequent this area**, posing a great danger.
